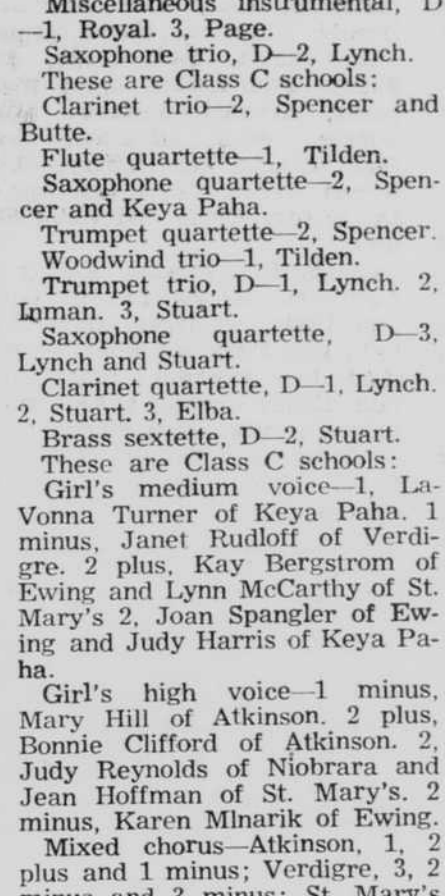

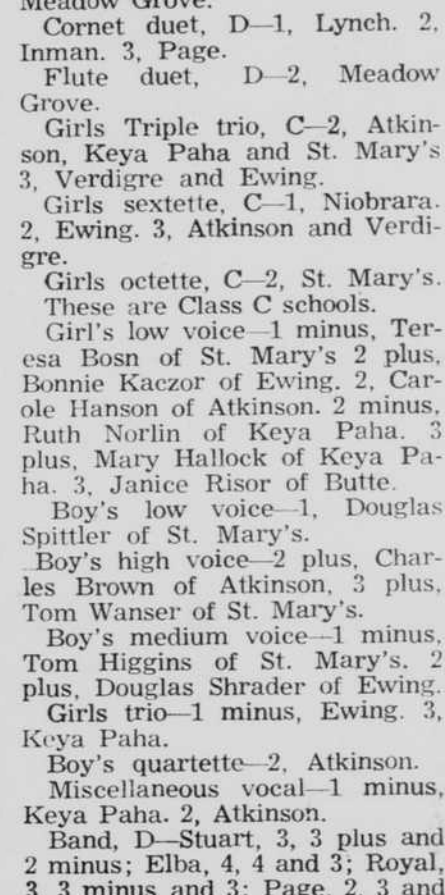
MISS ALVARA RAMM directs the O'Neill high glee as they sang Friday. They received a 3 plus, 2 and 3 rating from the judges.



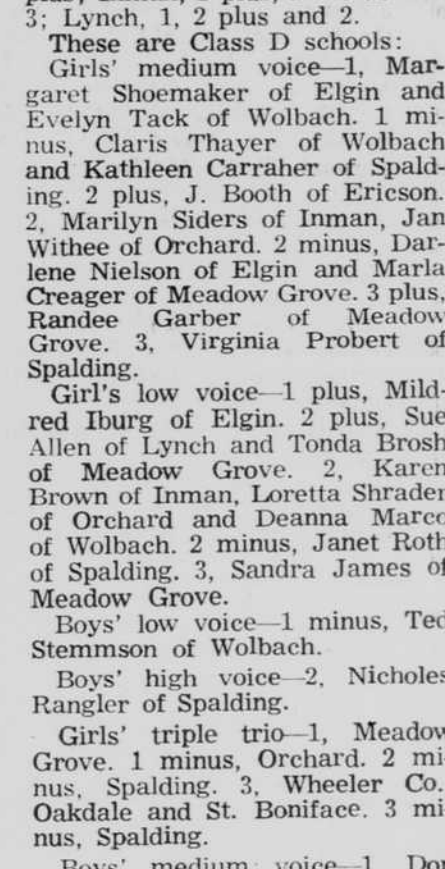

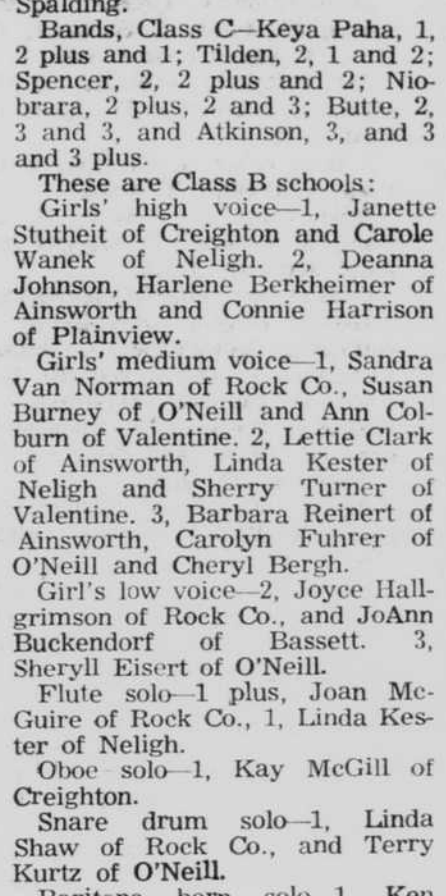

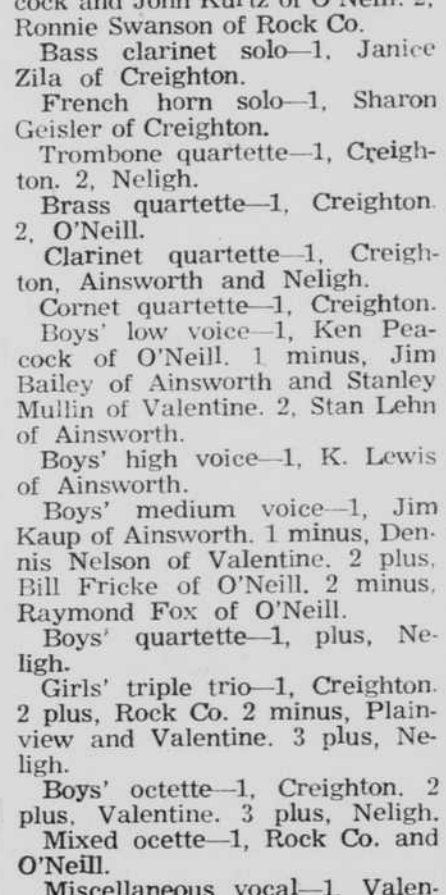
