

GRAPE AND PLUM JELLY Yield: about 13 medium glasses (6% lbs. jelly)

6½ cups juice (about 3 lbs. ripe Concord grapes and 3½ lbs. ripe plums)

8½ cups (3½ lbs.) granulated sugar 1 box (1% oz.) powdered fruit pectin

First, prepare the juice. Stem about 3 pounds fully ripe Concord grapes and crush thoroughly. Crush thoroughly about 3% pounds fully ripe plums. (Do not peel or pit.) Combine fruits. Add 1 cup water; bring to a boil and simmer, covered, 10 minutes. Place in jelly cloth or bag and squeeze out juice. Measure 6½ cups into a very large saucepan.

Then make the jelly. Measure sugar and set aside. Add fruit pectin to juice in saucepan and mix well. Place over high heat and stir until mixture comes to a hard boil. At once stir in sugar. Bring to a full rolling boil and boil hard 1 minute, stirring constantly. Remove from heat, skim off foam with metal spoon, and pour quickly into glasses. Cover jelly at once with 1/8 inch hot paraffin.
