An Ordinance providing for a levy to raise funds by taxation of property situated within the corporate limits of the City of O'Neill, Nebraska, for the fiscal year beginning the first Tuesday in May 1961, and ending the first Tuesday in May 1962.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'NEILL, NEBRASKA.
Section 1. That the City of O'Neill, Nebraska, make the following levy for taxation for the fiscal year beginning the first Tuesday in May, 1961, and ending the first Tuesday in May, 1962, on the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of O'Neill, Nebraska:
For General Purpose 3.40 mills on the dollar.
For Street Lighting 1.10 mills on the dollar.
For Fire Department Maintenance .50 mills on the dollar.
For Maintenance of Streets and Alleys 3 mills on the dollar.
For Airport Maintenance 1 mill on the dollar.
For Park Maintenance .50 mills on the dollar.
For Municipal Advertising .20 mills on the dollar.
For Water Bond Sinking Fund 1 mill on the dollar.
For Park Improvement Bonds 1 mill on the dollar.
For Intersection Bonds 2 mills on the dollar.
For Paving District No. 16 Bonds .70 mills on the dollar.
For Storm Sewer Bonds .60 mills on the dollar.
Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication as provided by law.
