

RESOLUTION eating a joint Airport Zoning rd in accordance with Sec-3-304, R. R. S. 1943.



Be it resolved by the Board of County Supervisors of Holt County, Nebraska, that:

It is hereby found and determined that: 1. The Stuart-Atkinson Municipal Airport is an airport owned and controlled jointly by the Village of Stuart and City of Atkinson, and is located five (5) miles outside the territorial limits of each of said cities.

2. The area of land and water extending out in all directions a distance of three miles from the adjacent boundaries of said airport constitutes an airport hazard area within the meaning of Sec. 3-301 (3) R. R. S. 1943.

3. Such airport hazard area, appertaining to the above mentioned airport, is located entirely within the County of Holt and entirely outside the territorial limits of the Village of Stuart and City of Atkinson.

4. It is necessary and expedient that the Village of Stuart and City of Atkinson, the political subdivisions owning and controlling the above named airport and the County of Holt, the political subdivision within which the airport hazard area is located, create a Joint Airport Zoning Board in accordance with Sec. 3-304 R. R. S. 1943.

The County of Holt does hereby participate with the Village of Stuart and the City of Atkinson in the creation of a Joint Airport Zoning Board, to be known as the Stuart-Atkinson Airport Zoning Board, and to that end there is hereby created a Joint Airport Zoning Board, to be so known, which board shall have and exercise all the powers conferred, and perform all the duties joined upon it by the Airport Zoning

Frank J. Bray and J. G. Brewster, residents of the County, are hereby appointed as members of such Joint Airport Zoning Board, to represent the County of Holt thereon.
