O'Neill Public School Office of the Superintendent September 4, 1962  
Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Education held on September 4, 1962 at 7:30 p.m. with all members present. Meeting was called to order by president Henry Lohaus. Minutes of the previous meeting of August 7 were read and approved. There was a motion by Dr. Wilson, seconded by Harold Weier with all members present, that a special meeting be called on Sept. 11 to pass on Bills now due. On account of other pressing business at this time it was not possible to get these bills processed in time for the regular meeting. Motion carried. There followed a discussion with attorney Julius Cronin taking part and advising the Board regarding the matter of acquiring the property adjacent to the present athletic field. Motion by Dr. Wilson seconded by Dr. Cook that the Board con- tact Dr. Kubitschek for the purpose of negotiating for the acquisition of Blocks B, C, D and E adjacent to the present athletic field, provided he can furnish a good title, and to include this business at the Special meeting to be held on 9-11-62. Motion carried. Motion by Dr. Wilson, seconded by Harold Weier that the Board have attorney J. D. Cronin contact Jack Berigan in the matter of establishing the property line to the east, as surveyed. Motion carried. Mr. McCoy reported that the Fire Alarm System is now receiving some attention by the contractor, but as yet the work is unfinished. It was decided that the contractor should again be notified that this work must be finished without further delay. Reporting on the enrollment Superintendent McCoy stated that there are 471 pupils in Kindergarten through Grade 8 and 212 in High School, for a total enrollment of 683. The 5th and 6th grades are now set up in the St. Mary's building and both teachers and pupils appear to be content in their temporary quarters, and all seems to be working out smoothly. Approval of these quarters has been issued by the State Fire Marshal with the provision that Break Glass sending stations be provided and connected to the present automatic fire detection system and an additional fire alarm bell be installed. Costs of operating these temporary quarters to the District and which expense represents total cost, is estimated to be as follows: \$1800 for Fuel, \$275 for Light and Power, \$275 for insurance, a total of \$2350. These estimates are based on one half of last years actual costs for the operation of the building, since Dist. 7 pupils will be occupying one half the total room space. Any overrun this year will be borne by the District. Any excess payment over actual cost will be refunded. Supt. McCoy reports that we have a very co-operative and congenial faculty this year. And that it is also of topnotch quality. No further business appearing the meeting adjourned. Morgan Ward, Secretary
