**DETECTION OF ELECTROMAGNETIC PHENOMENA**  
You can "taste" small electromagnetic currents. The human body is an ion solution (6 volts have killed). The first electromagnetic measuring device is a piece of magnetized iron or steel. It determines the presence of magnetic radiation which is the only thing that radiates. The second electrical measuring device consists of a pair of pith balls on fine thread. With these it can and was determined that static electricity had two characteristics, that the strength varied as the inverse square of the distance; that the substance could be treated by contact. The third device measured electromagnetic current only. It consists of shunt magnetic fields and a rotating device or armature whose travel is limited by springs of known strength. The fourth device is a substance of known impedance. It determines the heat component called wattage or horsepower. We use 746 watts to a H.P. The fifth device is chemical-ion solution, ion vapor and semi vacuum in which the elements exist with part of the electron shell disassociated.
