Charles Warren Stoddard has a paper of early Hawaii in November *Overland Monthly* that will be read with much interest.

Some interesting reminiscences of the early editors of California written by James O'Meara, will appear in the *Overland Monthly* for November.

Great foresight was shown by *Demorest's Family Magazine* in publishing, ten years ago, when an International Exhibition was then talked of, a map of the identical site that has now been chosen by the New York Committee for the World's Fair of 1892. In the November number of this famous magazine (just issued) this plan is reproduced, handsomely executed, and on extra fine paper. It includes all the buildings and the laying out of the grounds, and, to make it more comprehensive, a map of New York City is also given. The description that accompanies these designs gives a better idea of the site than anything that has yet been published.
