There can be but one objection urged as just us and that is that it is not good painty to centralize large bodies of men, that s rikes and 'abor trouble are sure to Intow. This objection should not be urged against Plattsmouth; while the U. P. bogs in Caraba have always paid better wages than are paid for like work here. in some last area almost twice as much, t there has never been any labor trouble enong the 600 men in the regular conployment of the company here. We have a far better class of laborers, more intelligent, and they are nearly all property owners bergely identified with he best interests of our city. Under the present wanagement it is safe to predict that there will never be a strike in the B. & M. shops at Plattsmouth.

The class of people we have wonlbe an advantage to the company, in throwing their weight against any labor trouble, so that the location of the sno, s here ught to be considered an advantage to company from this point of view rather than a disadvantage. We trust thegeneral manager for whose wisdom and fore ight we have the greatest respect, will give the prop sition from this city, the careful consideration, which to our minds it appears to deserve.
