PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, a joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska, at the Eighteenth Session thereof, and approved February 27th, A. D. 1883, proposing an Amendment to Section Four (4), of Article Three (3), of the Comstitution of said State, and that said section as amended shall read as follows, to-wit :

as follows, to-wit : "Section 4.—The term of office of members of the Legislature shall be two years, and they shall each receive a salary of three hundred dollars for their services during said term, and ten cents for every mile they shall travel in going and returning from the place of meeting of the Legislature, on the most usual route. *Provisial, however*, that neither members of the Legislature nor employees shall receive any pay or perquisites other than their salary and mileage. Each session, except special sessions, shall be not less than sixty days. After the expiration of forty days of the session no bills nor joint resolutions of the nature of bills shall be introduced, unless the Governor shall, by special mess-age, call the attention of the Leg-islature to the necessity of passing a law on the subject matter cabraced in the message, and the introduccion of bills shall te restricted thereto " thereto

The ballots at the election at which said Amendment shall be submitted shall be in the following form: "For proposed Amendment to the Constitution relating to Legislative Department." "Against proposed Amendment to the Constitution relating to Legislative Department."

WHEREAS, A joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska at the Eighteenth session thereof, and approved February 28th, A. D. 1883, proposing an amendment to Section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the constitution of said State, and that said section as amended shall read as follows, towit :

"Section 1-The Executive Department "Section 1 – The Executive Department shall consist of a Governor, Lieutenant Govern-or, secretary of State, Auditor of Public Ac-counts, Treasurer, Superintendent of Public Ins ruction, Attorney General, Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings, and Board of Railway Commissioners. The officers camed in this section scall each hold his office for the term of two years from the first Thus: day after the first The day in January next after his 8 p. m. Railway Commissioners. The officers named in this section shall each hold his office for the term of two years from the first Thusday after the first Tue-day in January next after his election and until his successor is elected and qualified. *Provided, however*, that the first Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November, 1886, and each succeeding election shall be held at the same relative time in each even year thereafter. All other officers that may be provided for by law under the provisions of this section, shall be choten in such manner and at such times, and shall hold their offices for such length of time as may be provided for by law. The Governor, Secretary of state, Auditor of Public Lands and Buildings, and Attorney General, shall reside at the seat of government during their terms of office, and keep the public records, books and papers there, and the officers betein named shall perform the following form : "For proposed Amendment to Section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the Constitution, entilled 'Excentive Department."
