STILL AT IT.  
Train Wreckers Succeed a Third Time in Their Dastardly Work.

In spite of the fact that since the Hubbell disaster the Republican Valley road has been hourly patrolled by an armed force, the villains who are bent on wreaking vengeance on the road succeeded on Tuesday in throwing the Cannon Ball train from the track near Wymore, this being the third train they have wrecked. The wreck was caused by an open switch. The engine and all the cars except the rear coach and sleeper were wrecked and are still lying in the ditch where they were thrown by the accident. The sleeper and coach kept the rails and went through to Atkinson five hours late. No one was injured.

The matter was kept quiet by the railroad authorities and hence did not transpire in time for publication yesterday morning.—State Journal.

PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, a joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska, at the Eighteenth Session thereof, and approved February 27th, a. d. 1883, proposing an Amendment to Section Four (4), of Article Three (3), of the Constitution of said State, and that said section as amended shall read as follows, to-wit:

"Section 4.—The term of office of members of the Legislature shall be two years, and they shall each receive a salary of three hundred dollars for their services during said term, and one cent for every nine miles they shall travel in attending the session, and in traveling to and from the Legislature, on the most usual route; provided, however, that neither members of the Legislature nor their employees, shall receive any compensation or other emoluments, other than subsistence. Each session, except special sessions, shall not be less than sixty days. After the expiration of forty days of the session no bills introduced after that date shall be considered bills introduced, unless the Governor, or his special messenger, call the attention of the Legislature to the necessity of passing a law on the subject matter embraced in the message, and the introduction of bills shall be restricted thereto."

The ballots at the election at which said Amendment shall be submitted shall be in the following form: "For proposed Amendment to the Constitution relating to Legislative Department." "Against proposed Amendment to the Constitution relating to Legislative Department."

WHEREAS, a joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska at the Eighteenth session thereof, and approved February 27th, a. d. 1883, proposing an amendment to Section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the Constitution of said State, and that said section as amended shall read as follows, to-wit:

"Section 1.—The Executive Department shall consist of a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, Attorney General, Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings, and Board of Highway Commissioners. The officers named in this section, and their successors in office for the term of two years from the first day of January in each year, shall hold their offices for such length of time as may be fixed by law, and shall perform such duties and receive such compensation as may be provided by law. The Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, Attorney General, Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings, and Attorney General, shall reside at the seat of government during their term of office, and keep the public records, books and papers there, are the officers herein named such persons, and the officers herein named shall perform such duties as may be required by law."

The ballot at the election at which such Amendment shall be submitted shall be in the following form: "For proposed Amendment to Section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the Constitution relating to Executive Department." "Against proposed Amendment to Section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the Constitution, entitled Executive Department."

Louis C. W. DAWES, Governor of the State of Nebraska, do hereby, by virtue of the Constitution, and the provisions of an act of the Legislature, make and declare the power of proposing Amendments to the Constitution and submitting the same to the Electors of the State, approved February 13th, a. d. 1883, that the ballot at the election at which such Amendment shall be submitted to the qualified voters of this State for ratification or rejection at the General Election to be held on the 4th day of November, a. d. 1884.

In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be affixed the Great Seal of the State of Nebraska.
