PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, a joint resolution was adopted by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska, at the Eighteenth Session thereof, and approved February 27th, A. D. 1883, proposing an Amendment to Section Four (4), of Article Three (3), of the Constitution of said State. and that said section as amended shall read as follows, to-wit :

as follows, to-wit:

"Section 4.—The term of office of metabers of the Legislature shall be two years, and they shall each receive a salary of three hundred dollars for their services during said term, and ten cents for every mile they shall travel in going and returning from the place of n eeting of the Legislature, on the most usual route. Provited, however, that neither members of the Legislature nor employees shall receive any pay or perquisites other than their salary and indicage. Each session, except special sessions, shall be not less than sixty days. After the expiration of forty days of the session no bills nor joint resolutions of the nature of bills shall be introduced, unless the Governor shall, by special mes-age, call the attention of the Legislature to the necessity of passing a law on the subject matter embraced in the mes-age, and the introduction of bills shall be restricted thereto."

The ballots at the election at which said Amendment shall be submitted shall be in the following form: "For proposed Amendment to the Constitution relating to Legislative Department." "Against proposed Amendment to the Constitution relating to Legis'ative Department." WHERE AS, A joint resolution was adopted

"Section 1—The Executive Department shall consist of a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State. Auditor of Public Accounts. Treasurer, Superimendent of Public Accounts. Treasurer, Superimendent of Public Accounts. Treasurer, Superimendent of Public Lins raction, Attorney General, Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings, and Board of Kallway Commissioners. The officers had been in this section and until his successor is elected and qualified. Provided, however, that the first election and until his successor is elected and qualified. Provided, however, that the first luesday succeeding the first Monday in November, 1886, and each succeeding election shall be held at the same relative time in each even year thereafter. All other officers that may be provided for by law under the provisions of this section, shall be cho en in such manner and at such times, and shall hold their offices for such length of time as may be provided by law, and shall perform such duties and receive such componentation as ray to provided for by law. The Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts. Treasurer, Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings, and Attorney General, shall reside at the seat of government during their terms of office, and keep the public records, books and papers there, and the officers herein named shall persuch duries as may be equired by law."
