PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, a joint resolution was adopted  
by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska,  
at the Eighteenth Session thereof, and approved  
February 27th, A. D. 1883, proposing an  
Amendment to Section Four (4), of Article  
Three (3), of the Constitution of said State,  
and that said section as amended shall read  
as follows, to-wit:

"Section 4.—The term of office of members  
of the Legislature shall be two years, and they  
shall each receive a salary of three hundred  
dollars for the services during said term, and  
ten cents for every mile they shall travel in  
going and returning from the place of meeting  
of the Legislature, on the most direct route,  
by the shortest route, and by the most direct  
route, and no other compensation shall be  
received by them for their services as mem-  
bers of the Legislature, except special sessions,  
shall be not less than sixty days. After the  
expiration of the term of office of any mem-  
ber, his successor shall be elected by the  
Legislature, and the necessity of passing a law on  
the subject matter embraced in the message, and  
the introduction of bills shall be restricted  
thereto."

The ballots at the election at which said  
Amendment shall be submitted shall be in the  
following form: "For proposed Amendment  
to the Constitution relating to Legislative De-  
partment." "Against proposed Amendment  
to the Constitution relating to Leg'stive  
Department."

WHEREAS, A joint resolution was adopted  
by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska  
at the Eighteenth session thereof, and approved  
February 28th, A. D. 1883, proposing an am-  
endment to Section One (1) of Article Five (5)  
of the constitution of said State, and that said  
section as amended shall read as follows, to-  
wit:

"Section 1.—The Executive Department  
shall consist of a Governor, Lieutenant Govern-  
or, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Ac-  
counts, Treasurer, Superintendent of Public  
Lands, Attorney General, Commissioner  
of Public Lands and Buildings, and Board of  
Railway Commissioners. The Governor shall  
hold his office for the term of two years, and  
shall be elected on the first Tuesday after the  
first day of January next after his election,  
and until his successor is elected and qual-  
ified. The Governor shall exercise the pro-  
visions of this section, shall be chosen in such  
manner and at such times, and shall hold their  
office for such length of time as may be pro-  
vided by law, and shall perform such duties  
and receive such compensation as may be pro-  
vided for by law. The Governor, Secretary of  
State, Auditor of Public Accounts, Treasurer,  
Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings,  
and Attorney General, shall reside at the seat  
of government during their terms of office, and  
keep the public records, books and papers  
there, and the officers herein named shall per-  
form such duties as may be required by law."

The ballots at the election at which said  
Amendment shall be submitted shall be in the  
following form: "For proposed Amendment  
to Section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the  
Constitution, entitled 'Executive Department.'  
"Against proposed Amendment to  
section One (1) of Article Five (5) of the Con-  
stitution, entitled 'Executive Department.'"

Therefore, James W. Dawes, Governor of  
the State of Nebraska, do hereby give notice,  
in accordance with Section One (1) Article Fif-  
teen (15) of the Constitution, and the provisions  
of an act entitled "An Act to provide the man-  
ner of proposing Amendments to the Constitu-  
tion and submitting the same to the Electors  
of the State," approved February 14th, A. D.  
1877 that said proposed Amendments will be  
submitted to the qualified voters of this State  
for ratification or rejection at the General  
Election to be held on the 4th day of Novem-  
ber, A. D. 1884.

In Witness Whereof, I have  
hereunto set my hand and caused to be  
affixed the Great Seal of the  
State of Nebraska.

Done at Lincoln, this 13th day  
of July, A. D. 1884 the Eighteenth  
year of the State, and of the Inde-  
pendence of the United States, the  
One Hundred and Ninth

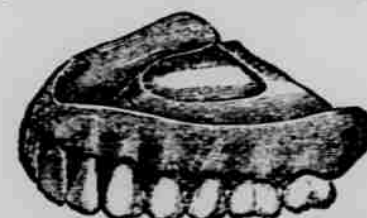
