OUR contemporary, the Journal, in their attempt to belittle the work performed by Hon. Robert W. Furnas, the present Secretary of the Nebraska State Board of Agriculture and defense him for re-election to the office has a very fine illustration in Wednesday's issue which we venture to say has no foundation in fact, and before answering the inquiry of our friend on Main street let us ask him to refer to the December file of his paper where he directs attention to the fact "that an itemized statement of the receipts and expenditures should be published by the Secretary as has been the custom and as the law directs," the article closing with an appeal to "Let us hear from Mr. Secretary Furnas." Permitted to ask that if Mr. Furnas resigned in September last to take effect in the month of July preceding why he should be scored for the financial disaster said to have followed the management of the last State Fair, or be invited to make reports which should be prepared by his successor; for if Mr. Furnas resigned, which is questionable, he would insist that some one be selected immediately to fill his place. Our friend, the Journal editor, has a well deserved reputation for honesty and fairness and we trust he will not be misled by malicious, lying and slanderous statements in reference to honest Robert W. Furnas.

THE HERALD desires to say but a word as to the action of the republican legislature which will convene at our capital in a few days, and that word is for our members to see to it, that as little legislation as possible is enacted. There are, however, some measures which are imperatively demanded by the people. One is a repeal at once of the blunder perpetrated by the last legislature making our taxes fall due and become payable, with a stiff penalty, on the first day of January—the time of year, of all others, when money is hard to get and when the citizen, as a rule, is called on by his creditor to "come and settle at once."

Another measure, demanded, is the enactment of a salutary law (if such a measure be possible) regulating freight and passenger traffic on our railroads. The last legislature was emphatically instructed by the people to give them a law of this nature; that instruction was disregarded, caused, by the dozen or more antimongopoly cranks and shysters who by some inscrutable dispensation of Providence, were permitted to occupy seats in either house, and very largely by the persistent and blind opposition of the railroads of the State, who, at that session, overwhelmed our law makers with their secret agents and lobby. Again such an instruction has been given by the people; there is scarcely a county in the State where the members elect have not, in order to secure their elec-

tion, pledged their constituents a railroad law. This demand of the people may be wise, or it may be foolish; yet, such is public sentiment today, and the HERALD insists upon the present legislature bowing to this sentiment, and going at the matter, at an early, and in a straightforward, honest manner, giving the people a law of this kind. Most of the Northwestern States, today, have enacted such laws, and we notice they do not repeal them. This is a republican legislature, and the party will doubtless be held responsible for its acts in regard to this important question. No dodging or trimming, gentlemen! Give us a good, strong, square-toed law on the subject, and let us see how it works.
