REPUBLICAN CONVENTION.

The Republican electors of the State of Nebraska are requested to send delegates from the several counties, to meet in convention, at the city of Omaha, Tuesday, May 15, 1888, at 8 o'clock p. m., for the purpose of electing four delegates to the National Republican Convention, which meets in Chicago June 19, 1888.

THE APPOINTMENT.

The several counties are entitled to representation as follows, being based upon the vote cast for Hon. Samuel Maxwell, supreme Judge, in 1887, giving one delegate-at-large to each county, and one for each 150 votes and major fraction thereof:

THE CAMERA'S MAGIC.

INGENIOUS USE OF PHOTOGRAPHY IN KINDRED ARTS.

An Interesting Chat with "The Old Man"—Modern Way of Making Watch Dials—The Sand Blast—A Costly Experiment—Enlarged Pictures.

Mr. T. C. Roach, familiarly known by photographers all over the United States and even in Europe as "the old man," is recognized by them as a sort of mahatma, one who, if he does not quite "know it all," is very liable to find out anything more that is to be discovered.

"Do you know that watch dials are now made by photography at a mere fraction of their former cost? They all used to be painted by hand. Now a hundred are made in the time formerly required to produce one, and each of the hundred is better than the one would have been.

"Speaking of that necessarily recalls to me the effort now making for the production, for purpose of magazine and book illustration, printed with type, of photographs from nature or paintings, by means of what are now called tint glasses.

"Well, a big company, many of United States officials, was formed for the development of Baron von Eglloffstein's discovery and its utilization for the printing of greenbacks and other paper money in such wise as to defy counterfeiting.

"But their expectations were not realized. Baron von Eglloffstein used a fine plate glass, covered with a very opaque etching ground, which was cross hatched by the finest possible lines, 500 to the inch, which was interposed between the light and the object, or the glass negative or positive, to be photographed.

"One of the late and possibly rather surprising discoveries in photography, which also is a patent of mine, is the enlargement of photographs to any required size without the aid of a solar camera, merely by the light of an ordinary oil lamp, or even by a flash of gun cotton.
