My residence of a few months in Portland has been one of constant delight and surprise. Coming, as I did, from the rigors of midwinter into the balmy air of spring, almost at a bound, as it were, I was so forcibly reminded of the contrast between the Pacific coast and the entire region from the Rocky mountains to the Atlantic, that I am not likely ever to forget it.

One of the pleasures of the cool, early summer in Portland is that of driving on the well-paved streets, or upon the excellent roads leading along the river, or upon the hills lying west of the city. To the pleasure incident to riding behind a fast horse on a hard, even road, is added the constant presence of beautiful landscapes, glimpses, at times, of mountains, shading off in the distance from green to blue and purple, and culminating in the snowy masses of the Cascade summits.
