REPUBLICAN PLATFORM.

The republicans of the United States, assembled by their delegates in national convention, pause on the threshold of their proceedings to honor the memory of the great leader and immortal champion of liberty and the rights of the people, Abraham Lincoln, and to remember and gratefully acknowledge the noble names of our later leaders who have been more recently called away from our councils.

In the spirit of those great leaders and of our devotion to human liberty, and with that hostility to all forms of despotism and oppression which is the fundamental idea of the republicanism in central America and of foreign trade everywhere among our neighbors.

We affirm our unwavering devotion to the maintenance of the inviolable and inseparable union of states to the autonomy reserved to the states under the constitution.

We accept the issue, and respectfully appeal to the people for their judgment. The protective system must be maintained. The tariff has always been followed by general disaster to all interests except those of the insurer and the speculator.

We denounce the Mills' bill as destructive to general business, labor, and the farming interest. We accept the issue, and respectfully appeal to the people for their judgment.

AGAINST PAUPER AND LABOR TRUSTS. We declare hostilely to the introduction into this country of foreign contract labor, and of Chinese labor, and to the introduction of any other system of labor which is not a free and independent system.

ADMISSION OF TERRITORIES. The government by congress of the territories is based upon necessity only to the end that they may become states in the union.

THE MORNING QUESTION. The political power of the Mormon church in the territories is a menace to the liberties of the people.

OUR MERCHANT MARINE. We earnestly recommend that prompt action be taken by congress in the enactment of such legislation as will best secure the rehabilitation of our American merchant marine.
