**ABOUT CITY TAXES.**

**To the Editor of THE NEWS:**

The county commission should seriously consider the desirability of purchasing city property for delinquent taxes, and perhaps advance money that will never return to the treasury. Every one knows that city property is rated from two to ten times more than its present cash value. THE NEWS published the rate and taxes of the McCook property to Robert Carnes. The price paid was \$200, and the taxes for '97 was \$27.50—this is over 9 per cent of its cash value, and 27 1/2 per cent of its one-third value of what the assessor should value it at for taxation, but it seems it was assessed three times its value. Other property in the city is even worse. A Bohemian bought a house and two lots for \$15 and he found the taxes for '97 was \$8.10. Calculate what per cent that is.

Let the county commissioners request property owners in the city to come before them and explain their grievances and pay in proportion. Those that will not come let the commissioners deal with them as they may think right and just.
