OLD GLORY TO FLOAT OVER CUBA IN A SHORT TIME

Our Troops Will Land and Co-operate With Insurgents. THE SPANISH FLEET IS COMING

To Do Us Battle, Maybe—Nebraska's Troops to Mobilize at Fort Crook Wednesday—Will Get to the Front—Other Items.

NEW YORK, April 29.—Portugal has announced neutrality in the difficulty with Spain. The Spanish fleet sailed from Cape Verde islands at 8:25 this morning in a southerly direction.

It will urge the insurgents to place themselves under the stars and stripes as soon as the American colors shall be raised upon Cuban soil, and to have absolute confidence in the fair intentions of President McKinley and his administration.

WAR NOTES. Twelve hundred sergeants have applied at Washington for places in the army. Holt county has organized a company of volunteers.

There is great dissatisfaction in every state because so few who are anxious to go to the front can do so. Illinois alone claims she could furnish the entire quota of 125,000 men called for by the president.

General John F. Reynolds, who died at the head of the First Army Corps, which opened the battle of Gettysburg was a captain when Sumpter was fired upon.

A Cuban war correspondent finds time to tell about a Spanish girl in Havana whose "eyes rest upon and follow you—large, dark and beaming, half-veiled with long lids and lashes."

A sim, pale-faced dry goods clerk in Boston, with no military experience in 1861, was a major general in 1865, and he is now a major general of regulars, at the head of the American army.
