## SAD ACCIDENT AT METROPOLIS

#### Infant Burned to Death in Fire in City of Omaha.

OMAHA, Nov. 10 .- Aggie Zidirich is dead and her sistersRosie and Annie, aged four and two years, respectively, are dangerously burned from a fire which occurred in this city yesterday.

After Mr. Zidirich had gone to work his wife took the coal basket and went out on the railroad tracks to pick up coal, as was her custom, leaving the three children in the house. Soon after Adam Gracer, an old man who happened to be passing, heard screams from the house and saw smoke coming from the burning building. He attempted to force open the door but failed. With his bare fist he smashed out the window and crawled into the bedroom, which by that time was a seething mass of flames.

Chokingly the aged man stumbled through the smoke and flames to the bed where the helpless babies lay. Snatching one in his arms Gracer made his way out of the house. deposited his writhing burden on the ground and returned to the burning house. He made two more trips, rescuing all of the children.

The infant lived but a few minutes and was dead before an ambulance arrived. The two older girls were rushed to a hospital, where efforts are being made to save their lives.

When Mrs. Zidirich returned from the tracks and learned of the terrible disaster, her mind gave way under its burden of grief. She is being detained to prevent her doing violence to herself.
