ORAL ARGUMENT ON REFERENDUM

Supreme Court Listens to Statements of Opponents. IS ALLEGED UNCONSTITUTIONAL

Washington, Nov. 4.—The critical manner in which the supreme court of the United States listened to arguments that the initiative and referendum method of legislation in this country is unconstitutional brought encouragement to the friends of the system.

Chief Justice White Demands Proof of Assertions Made by Attorney—Guaranty to States Involved—Legality of Taxes Questioned.

White Asks for Proof. "What are the restrictions which you claim are violated in this particular case?" inquired Chief Justice White.

States Alone Interested. George Fred Williams of Boston argued that only a party to the "guaranty" to states could ask the United States to make good its promise that every state should have a republican form of government.
