

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

Plattsmouth, Nebraska, Sept. 8th, 1914.

Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present, C. E. Heebner, Julius A. Pitz and C. R. Jordan, County Commissioners, Frank J. Libershal, County Clerk. Minutes of previous sessions read and approved, when the following business was transacted in regular form.

County clerk reported having issued a Peddler's license to C. W. Jewell, permitting him to sell, or peddle various remedies within Cass County, Nebraska, for a period of one year, outside of the limits of any city or incorporated village.

Resignation of Calvin H. Taylor as county attorney of Cass county, Nebraska, received and same laid on the table.

Petitions received from legal voters of South Bend, Elmwood and Salt Creek precincts, containing names of 161 signers, petitioning the Board of County Commissioners to enter an order submitting the question of electing a county assessor in said county to said electors Statutes of Nebraska for 1913.

The above petitions refused by board on account of not complying with section 1955, of Revised Statutes of Nebraska for 1913 which provides that in any county upon presentation of a petition to the county board, not less than sixty days before any general election signed by a least ten per cent of the electors of the county secured in not less than two-fifths of the townships or precincts of said county, the proposition shall be submitted to the electors of said county.
