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PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. THREE.

The following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, as hereinafter set forth in full, is submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska, to be voted upon at the general election to be held Tuesday, November 3rd, A. D. 1914.

Section 1. That at the general election for state and legislative officers, to be held on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in November, 1914, the following be submitted as amendments to Sections 1 and 2, of Article V, of the Constitution of Nebraska:

Section 1. The executive department shall consist of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, and Treasurer. The Governor shall hold his office for a term of two years from the first Thursday after the first Tuesday in January, each after his election, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

Section 2. That at said election on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November, 1914, on the ballot to be printed or written the words: "For proposed amendments to the constitution of the State of Nebraska, to be voted upon at the general election to be held Tuesday, November 3rd, A. D. 1914."

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. ONE.

The following proposed amendment to the constitution of the State of Nebraska, as hereinafter set forth in full, is submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska, to be voted upon at the general election to be held Tuesday, November 3rd, A. D. 1914.

Section 1. The rules of taxation shall be uniform as to any given class and taxable property shall be levied upon such property as the Legislature may prescribe. Taxes may also be imposed on incomes, privileges and occupations, which taxes may be graduated and progressive and reasonable exemption may be provided, in addition to those hereinafter specifically mentioned in section 2 of this article.

Section 2. That at the general election to be held on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in November, 1914, on the ballot to be printed or written the words: "For proposed amendments to the constitution of the State of Nebraska, to be voted upon at the general election to be held Tuesday, November 3rd, A. D. 1914."

Section 3. That at the general election for state and legislative officers to be held on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in November, 1914, the following be submitted as amendments to Sections 1 and 2, of Article V, of the Constitution of Nebraska:
