

Washington, D. C., June 26 .- Further details of the plan by which the Omaha Loses Cantonment Selection young men to compose the new national army will be selected impersonally from Washington were learned today.

> Under the plan proposed by General Crowder every card in every registration unit in the United States will be numbered from one up to the GENERAL BARRY FUTILE limit of registration in that unit.
