When these were handed down from the mount by God through Moses and were delivered unto the people they pronounced them good. Governments were instituted among men and laws particularly applicable to the particular governments were made and, in most cases, with a view to the best interests of the people International law or the comity of nations have been established that their relations might be more agreeable and that safety and justice might prevail.

Then came some of the Pharasees to the Master saying as they desired to entangle Him in the meshes of law with what they thought was a hard question and asked Him whether it were right to give tribute unto Caesar, as he, the ambassador of the most high God, was teaching that all nust give obedience to God.

Improved They had thought that if He should say that there was no cause for rendering obedience unto Caesar they would complain against Him to the Roman law, and if He did say to respect the law of Rome, then the people would forsake Him and therefore they asked the question.

The Master said where is the tribute money? When it was produced He asked whose image and subscription is this on the coin. They said it is Caesar's. Then came the reply, "Render unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's and unto God the things which are of God.

In other words He wished to impress on them that it was necessary for all to observe the laws under which they live.


