No matter how well you feed or care for such a calf, it can never respond and make a win-ner for you. The best calf that you \$ 28.35 can obtain within a range of reasonable price limits is none too good to use in your project. It is well, however, not to bid too far above cur-\$ 6.14 rent market prices in making your selection."
