Democrats are Pledged to Slash Expenditures

Putting Shoulders Behind Task of Solving Hoover Administration Deficit Problem.

Washington—Congressional democrats plan to put their shoulders behind the task of solving the Hoover administration's deficit problem by slashing expenses and raising funds through taxation and government borrowing. The president received assurances from Chairman Byrns, of the house appropriations committee, that the democrats would "do everything possible to diminish the government's expenditures." The Tennessee democrat visited the white house as democrats informally discussed their tax plans. These are to be put on paper next Tuesday, when the senate and house joint policy committee begins drafting the party's legislative program.

As opposition to the administration proposal for a retroactive tax on incomes for 1931 increased, Speaker Garner announced the democrats planned a thorough study of the Hoover-Mellon tax proposals before submitting revenue raising bills to the house for action. The democrats are opposed to a general sales tax and look with disfavor on the administration's plan to lower exemptions in order to collect taxes on low salaried men and wage earners.

Chairman Collier, of the house ways and means committee that initiates all revenue legislation, said he joined Senator Harrison of Mississippi, ranking democrat of the finance committee, in opposing increased taxes to be paid on income of 1931.

"I am going to fight any attempt to force a retroactive tax on the people or business," Collier said. "It would do more to depress business than any one thing the federal government could do now. That would be the last thing I would favor as long as there is any other way to raise the needed revenue."—State Journal.
