Tradition An old German legend is that a white hare steals into the house the night before Easter and hides the beautiful vari-colored eggs for good little children. In America the hare is called a rabbit, and little children make nests in which the rabbit may

deposit the eggs. Just why the white rabbit is connected with this custom is of interest. The rabbit is nocturnal in habit, coming out at night. The female carries its young for one month, thus representing the lunar month.

Another legend is that when the moon is full there is a dark patch which resembles a rabbit. But the rabbit did not always live in the moon. He was once a little earth rabbit who lived in India. One day a duck, a fox, and a monkey and this little rabbit decided to retire to the wilderness together and lead a religious life.
