"For the first time in my life, I haven't a single responsibility," he said. "For thirty-five years I held one important executive position after another. No man who is responsible to or for others ever gets a real vacation. Se may escape for a time from the telephone or the raido, but he can't escape the burden which he must carry with him always.

"It is surprising," he went on, "how much enjoyment and satisfaction a man with no responsibilities can get out of the most trivial things."

We talked about other things, of course, but I won't gossip about those. The things that impressed was that Mr. Hoover, unlike many men who have been accustomed to hard work their lives, has learned how to relax. Tension kills more men than disease.
