

**JAPAN GAINS MILLION**  
Tokyo.—The population of Japan increased by slightly more than 1,000,000 persons during the year, ended Oct. 1, the statistics reported. Japan Proper had a population of about 70,150,000, of which about a third was centered in urban settlements, the report said. The census showed there were approximately 190,000 more men than women. The population of Tokyo alone exceeded 6,000,000.

**THE BRIGHTEST FRESHMAN**  
Fremont, Neb.—Possessing knowledge equal to that expected in a man of 38 with like education, David Stowe, 17, Council Bluffs, has stamped himself as the "brightest" of Midland college 150 freshmen. He is a journalism major.  
Stowe gained the rating by scoring 215.5 out of a possible 229 points in an Iowa silent reading test.  
The score was the highest ever made by a Midland freshman. Average for the class was 127.  
Stowe scored a perfect 62 in the

reading comprehension division, more than double the 30.7 average. Lawrence Lantz, Lexington, was also perfect in reading comprehension.  
Second in the class was Doris Ayres Winnebago, who scored 210.5 points. Next were George Sanderson, Fremont, with 210; Katherine Frandsen, Fremont, 205; and Elna Lund, Arlington, 199.

**BELL PENSIONS CONTINUE**  
New York.—Social security pensions will not affect the company-financed retirement plan of the Bell Telephone system, it was announced Tuesday. The 270,000 employees eligible to draw upon the \$195,000,000 pension funds of the Bell system may do so in amounts equal to the full company pension plus one-half of the government pension. Workers do not contribute to the company fund.  
Should the social security act be changed before 1942 the organization will draft a new policy. The Bell system was the first of the big corporations with private retirement funds to announce its policy in connection with the new federal law.

**FARMERS TO GET REFUND**  
East St. Louis, Ill.—Commission firms at the national stockyards are preparing to make approximately 75,000 refunds to farmers on rates charged last winter and spring for the handling of pigs and hogs.  
More than 20,000 of the refund checks will be for less than 10 cents, commission men said. The average amount will be about 40 cents, making a total of \$30,000 for the 75,000 refunds. The refunds were made necessary by a decision of the U. S. supreme court in a Chicago case upholding the right of the secretary of agriculture to fix commission rates for the handling of livestock.
