Budget and Levy Takes Much of the Commissioners' Time—List of Claims Allowed.

During August the Commissioners were busy with the completion of the budget and setting of the levy for the year 1939, in addition to their regular duties.

In the adoption of the budget, every governing factor, every possible source of revenue and every feasible reduction in expenditures was considered, in order to hold the direct tax levy to the lowest possible figure. After lengthy consideration the budget was set and the Commissioners acting as a Board of Equalization, set the mill levy at 4.40 mills.

The County Clerk was instructed to publish a call for Bridge Bids to be filed on or before noon, September 19, and opened at 2:00 p. m. that day.
