LOWELLS AND FALL RIVERS.

St. Louis Republic. Mr. Bryan of Nebraska has been making a point against the New England sectionalists who make political capital out of the activity of southern and western congressmen in tariff reform.

"They have no Lowells in the south and west," says the New England republicans, chiding after Reed.

Mr. Bryan proceeds to show that the people of the west and south are more likely to exert their intelligence boldly and fearlessly by not living in Lowells and Lynns.

In Lowell there are 14,836 families occupying homes. Only 14 per cent own unincumbered homes. The percentage in Lynn is 16. In Fall River only 9 per cent own free homes. In Holyoke the percentage is between 6 and 7 per cent.
