Democratic State Convention.
The democratic state central committee hereby calls a delegate convention of the democrats of the state of Nebraska to meet at Lincoln, Neb., at the Funk opera house, on Tuesday, August 2, 1898, at 2 o'clock p. m., for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following state offices to be filed at the ensuing election: Governor, lieutenant governor, treasurer, secretary of state, attorney general, auditor of public accounts, commissioner of public lands and buildings, and superintendent of public instruction; and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention. All citizens who believe in the principles of the democratic party as declared in the Chicago platform, and who intend to affiliate with the democratic party are invited to participate in the selection of delegates to this convention.

Each county is requested to send one delegate for each 100 votes or major fraction thereof cast for Hon. Wm. J. Bryan for United States senator at the general election of 1894. Counties casting less than 100 votes for such candidate will send one delegate.

The headquarters of the democratic state committee will be at the Lindell hotel, where delegate tickets may be had.

Under the above apportionment Cass county will be entitled to twenty-one (21) delegates in the convention, the entire number entitled to seats being 813.

Cash For State Convention.
LINCOLN, Neb., July 1st, 1898.—The People's Independent Party electors of the state of Nebraska, are hereby requested to send delegates from their respective counties to meet in convention in the city of Lincoln, on Tuesday August 2nd, 1898, at 2 o'clock p. m. at the Oliver Theater, for the purpose of placing in nomination candidates for the following state offices:

1. Governor.
2. Lieutenant Governor.
3. Secretary of State.
4. Auditor of Public Accounts.
5. Treasurer.
6. Superintendent of Public Instruction.
7. Attorney General.

Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention. The representation is based upon one delegate at large for each county, and one delegate for each one hundred votes or major fraction thereof, cast for Judge John J. Sullivan for supreme judge at the election of 1897.

Under this apportionment, Cass county is entitled to twenty-four (24) delegates, the total number entitled to seats in the convention being 1116.

It is recommended that no proxies be allowed, and that the delegates present cast the full vote of their respective delegations.

And it is further recommended that all persons who believe in the principles as advocated by the Peoples Independent party, who have not connected themselves heretofore with said party, are hereby invited to participate in the deliberations of the same.

The headquarters of the committee will be at the Lincoln Hotel Cor. 9th and F St., where delegate tickets may be had.
