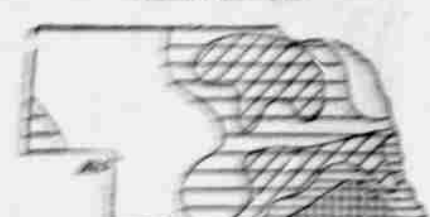

The first half of the week was hot with strong southerly winds and the latter part cool with northerly winds.

The rainfall was above the normal in the southeastern section, where it ranged from 1 to 4.5 inches, about normal in the northeastern and central portions of the state, and slightly below normal in the western counties.

The hot dry weather the first of the week was trying to all crops, especially in parts of the southeastern section.

Apples are dropping badly.

Gage - Winter grain nearly all cut, oat harvest begun...

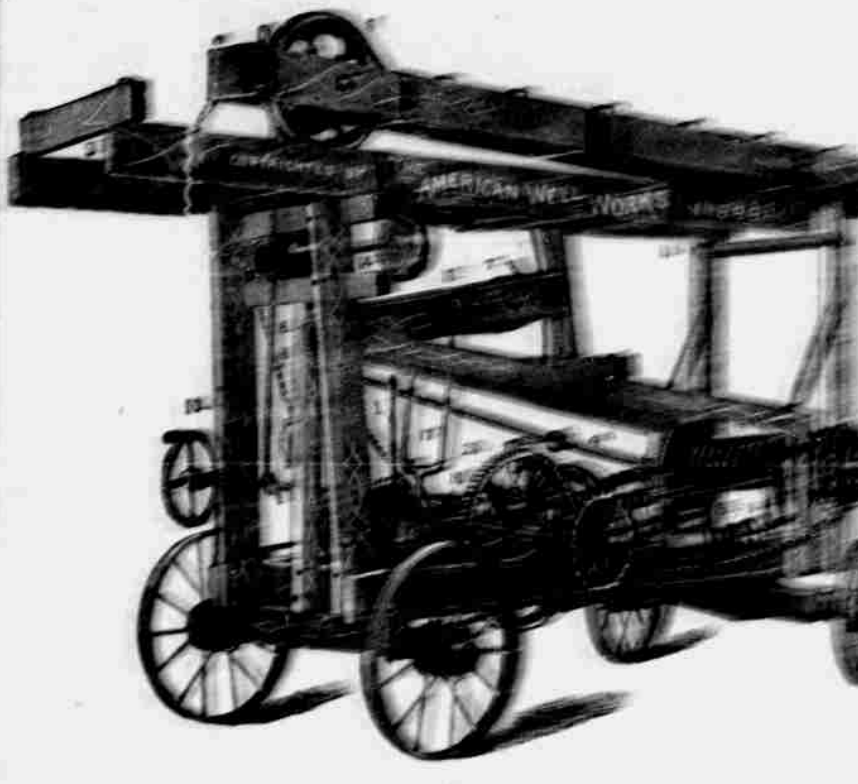
