Iod, and these witnesses, do Almighty God, and these witnesses, do solemnly promise, declare and swear, that I wili support and defend the constitation of the United States, and the atate where I reside; I will keep inviolate the secrets of this organization; I will obeg its constitution and laws; I will use my best endeavora to promote olvil and religious liberty; I will not knowingly vote for, recommend for, nor appoint, nor assist in electing, or appointing i Roman Catholio nor any perton aym. pathising with Roman Catholicism, to any political position whatever, and in any pontical position whatever, and in
all my publio and politioal action will be governed by the prineiples of thil order; I will oppose all attempts to use the publio funds for any sectarian purpose whatever and will ever maintail the great prinoiple of one general unsectarian free sehool organization; will never reveal any of the nigns,
rips, words, passwords or other mys. ceries of this order, or the names of any of its members, or its numerion strength, to the uninittated; I will hold these prineiples above my party afllilation; I will always give a brother of this order preference in all matters of business and also in my aet of electiva ranchise, all things being equal. I will make prompt reports to the ohlof recording Becretary of every initiation made by me. I will advocate the prin. ciples of this order. I will use my best sideavors to initiate all true men, and in this way help spread the order; all his I voluntarily promise, declare and wear (or aflirm) without hesitation of mental reservation, or any self evailou of mind in me, whatever, so help me God." (Recently incorporated as the Ameriean League.)"
