Two Important Decisions. At Topeka, Kan., on March 5, the supreme court handed down a decision in the quo warranto proceedings of D. K. Horton and others against E. Wilder and others. The parties to the suit are stockholders in the San Diego Land company, incorporated under the laws of Kansas.

The court also handed down an opinion in the case of the state against George Nolan. This case is important because it calls in question the Kansas law prescribing punishment for all crimes, and had not the decision of the lower court been sustained, the Kansas penitentiary would have been depopulated. His attorney appealed the case to the supreme court, claiming that the failure to insert in the Kansas law the words "in the penitentiary" after the words "confined at hard labor" was a fatal omission.
