That I will go to any part of the world whithersoever I may be sent, to the frozen regions of the north, to the burning sands of the desert of Africa, or the pingles of India, to the centers of civilization of Europe, or to the wild haunts of the barbarous savages of America, without murmuring or repining, and will be submissive in all things whatsoever, communicated to me.

LIBERTY OF CONSCIENCE. I do further promise and declare that, notwithstanding I am disposed with to assist any religion heretical for the propagation of the mother church's interest, to keep secret and private all her agents' counsels from time to time, as they entrust me, and not to divulge, directly or indirectly, by word, writing or circumstances whatsoever, but to execute all that shall be proposed, given in charge, or discovered unto me, by you my ghostly father, or any of this sacred convent.

THE OBEYERS ARE: First—To maintain and promote the interests of Americans, and shield them from the depressing effects of foreign competition. Second—To assist Americans in obtaining employment. Third—To encourage Americans in business. Fourth—To establish a sick and funeral fund. Fifth—To maintain the public school system of the United States of America, and to prevent sectarian interference therewith, and uphold the reading of the Holy Bible therein.
