Breath-Proof Fodder Plants.

The State Agricultural Experiment Station recommends the following for the true grasses: Flanders grass, grass, rye grass, ryegrass, orchard grass, grass, sheep grass, these all grow well and are not affected by frost. How they will stand a pressure test is a question yet to be solved. Alfalfa does well. Red clover stands in the sun and has a fair growth, but is not suited to hard ground or spring soil.
