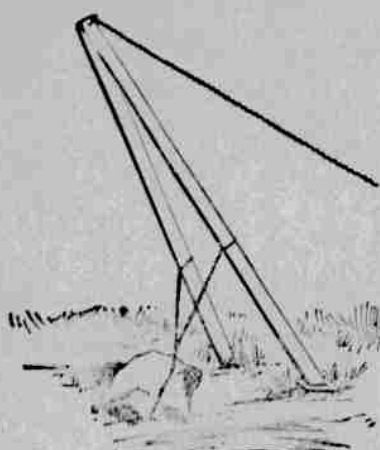


Its Recent Ascent by Swiss and Italian Mountaineers.

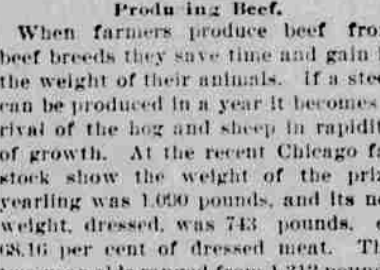

Stacking Corn Fodder. In some sections of the country corn fodder is tied in bundles and stacked like grain. The bundles are bound with straw bands in convenient size for handling.

Cob Coal for Hogs. One who raises from 100 to 150 pigs should aim to save at least 200 bushels of corn for charcoal. Make a pit 4 1/2 feet deep, 12 to 18 inches in diameter at bottom, 4 1/2 to 5 feet at top.
