The recent census of Switzerland shows that German is spoken by 2,312,105 persons, French by 732,220, Italian by 292,247. Romansh, a dialect of Latin, is spoken by 33,617 persons—say about 12 persons in a thousand; therefore, French is spoken by 330 persons, Italian by 67 persons, German by 697 persons in a thousand.
