**NOTICE TO NON-RESIDENT DEFENDANT.**  
To George D. Canon, non-resident defendant: You are hereby notified, that on the 26, day of September, A. D. 1902, W. Chauncy Phipps and George A. Phipps, as plaintiffs, filed in the district court of Sioux county, Nebraska, their petition against you as defendant, the object and prayer of which is for a decree satisfying and discharging two certain mortgages executed by them to you on the 15th day of July, A. D. 1901, securing the payment of two notes of that date executed by them to you, one for \$200.00 due in six months and one for \$500.00 due in one year, both of which notes having been fully paid, one of said mortgages being on the plant of the Harrison Press Journal, a news paper of said county, and consisting of two presses, one paper cutter, one imposing stone and stands, job, display and body type, including leads, rules, slugs, quads, spaces, etc., and the other of said mortgages being on lot 15teen (15) in block two (2) of the town (now village) of Harrison, formerly Bowen, in said county, and to recover a penalty of \$100.00 for your failure and refusal to release said mortgages upon payment thereof, as is proper demand, and for general relief. 
