To George D. Canon, non-resident defendant: You are hereby notified, that on the 26, day of September, A. D. 1902, W. Chauncey Phipps and George A. Phipps, as plaintiffs, filed in the district court of Sioux county, Nebraska, their petition against you as defendant, the object and prayer of which is for a decree satisfying and discharging two certain mortgages executed by them to you on the 15th day of July, A. 


