other than the delinquent or his agent unless the Commissioner of Public lands and buildings sees fit to hold such land from market until offered at public auction under the law. Just as soon as lease application, and payments is filed with the court Treasurer the last opportunity to redeem same has expired. It is also well to state that it will be the policy of this office that when the holder of a lease or sale contract permits it to go to forfeiture, that neither this person nor his agent can again lease the land without paying all back interest. It is the sense of this office that every one so desiring to hold this contract, and every chance consistent with the law will be given him to retain his land, provided he shows a disposition to pay for the use of it. I would also recommend that lease holders pay one year in advance, when making January payments as this will save time and trouble of making July payments at a busy time of year.

IMPORTANT.

Parties Holding School Land Leases Read Carefully.

After forfeiture has been made, and entered neither lease nor sale contract will be designated except on full payment of interest or rental for the current term in which reinstatement is asked. That is to say, if the sale contract is one year appears on Jan. 1st, 1903 or lease contract six months in arrears at that time, the interest for the year 1903 will have to be paid on sale contracts, and the rental for the first half of 1903 will be required to be paid on lease contracts before reinstatement can take place. The Board of Educational Lands, and funds has requested this office to follow the law in the matter of notices, and as the law prescribes that notices be served, and forfeiture made once a year, and in view of the fact that I shall endeavor to hold auction this year upon all lands declared forfeited, I shall have to ask the Board to make a forfeiture as soon as the 90 days have expired. This places the land subjected to lease to the first applicant
