A congressman is elected by the people, the house of representatives has full and absolute control of its members as to seating and unseating, and when a vacancy occurs it must be filled by an election if at all. is our understanding.

The senate committee on the state prison has recommended that a part of the convicts be hereafter employed in the manufacture of binder twine, which suggestion should be favorably considered. This is an industry that effects every community in the state, and one that combines work much hardship to our farmers with. Let the state manufacture our twine.

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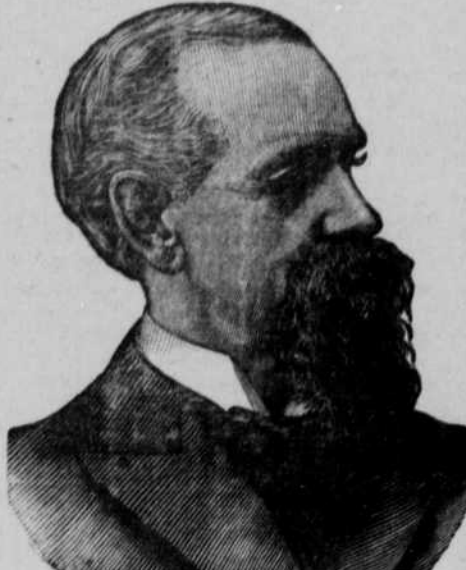

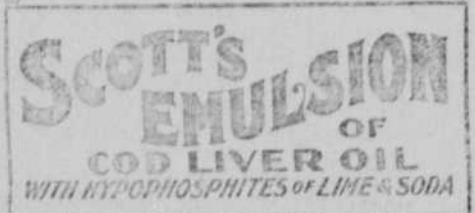
