### Official Paper Sherman County

The Boers have got us without a drop of blood being spilled.

The Junior editor of this paper extends greetings to the editor of the Times. We couldn't help it Eddy the boys are to blame.

Why is it that if you send a populist to war, ninety-nine times out of a hundred he returns a republican. The only solution heard of is that it makes a patriot out of him and he then drops in where he belongs.

Sherman county has again gone populist to about the same extent that it has for the past decade. They have elected every thing in the county as far as heard from except the Loup City township ticket, which they kindly allowed us to have entire this year.

Three of the Spanish war vessels which Admiral Dewey sent to the bottom of Manila harbor that memorable May morning, have been reconstructed by Lieutenant Hobson, and one, the Isla de Luzon, has already had her trial trip and proved a success. She will now take her place with our fleet in the Philippines and guard the interests of Uncle Sam without the aid or consent of W. J. Bryan or any other man.

England has again caught a Tartar and her war cry "Remember Majuba Hill," has again been a reality with her and she will have as much reason to remember Ladysmith, hereafter as she had Majuba in the past. The flower of her army has been cut down or captured and the balance of it in the Transvaal is surrounded and closely beleaguered, England means to win and will in the end, there is no doubt. Reinforcements and munitions of war are hurrying to the relief of her troops and though many of them may fall or be captured before assistance reaches them the "Hand writing is on the wall," the Boer will be crushed and England will rule South Africa before the Yankee celebrates his next 4th of July. It matters not where our sympathies are the inevitable is close.

In estimating the crowd at the Bryan meeting last week we tried to make a fair and impartial count, and the best we could do placed it at 600. Mr. Badura, county treasurer, said he placed it at 650 while Mr. Patton, our populist sheriff, thought there was 800, so we took the highest figure and one made by a populist, so that no one could charge us with underestimating on political grounds. Now what we are trying to learn is who made the estimate for our esteemed contemporary. We do not like to think that Mr. Brown would seek to mislead as he is very closely identified with the M. E. church, and we are not going to charge him with it, but some fellow stretched his imagination wonderfully when he said there was two thousand people in attendance.

The Republican rally at this place last Friday night was the grandest success of any held in Loup City for some years. The weather proved too cold to hold the meeting in a tent and the next best thing, the renting of the largest hall in town was resorted to. The Hall was completely packed, there not being stand-

ing room even on the platform of the steps out side, and many were turned away. The estimate of the crowd up-stairs, made by Mr. Pedler was 400. Mr. Webster disappointed no one. He made a speech that has not been equaled for good judgement and loyalty in Sherman for many years. He abused no one, and as there is no excuse or explanation necessary from Republican orators. He went to business at once and told the people just what the party had done and would do, and all seemed well pleased except a very few who has fell out with the world and soured with all mankind.

From the latest advices on the election Nebraska has again gone fusion about 15,000. She has given a majority almost equal to the best in the early days of that combination Mr. Bryan says it is a "rebuke to the administration," which may be a fact when the false doctrines of him and his comrades are taken into account, but the news from other states, even those bordering us would indicate otherwise. All northern states except Nebraska and Utah seem to have given an increased republican majority, even South Dakota and Kansas, while Kentucky goes Republican by about 8,000. This would indicate that only fusion ridden Nebraska had a "rebuke for the administration." Listen, results of this election show that the Republican party in the United States has a gain sufficient to entitle them to eleven more electoral votes than they received in 1896. Our state, by her action in electing a confessed pass-grabber and ballot fraud to the supreme court has only plunged herself deeper into the mire of discredit that has hung over us like a pall for the past eight years, and which will take a long time to redeem ourselves from.

Iowa gives her Republican governor a majority of 53,000, Pennsylvania 69,000, Ohio 50,000, New Jersey 10,000, Massachusetts 65,000, Kentucky 8,000, and New York 35,000. The above results show that the administration has been endorsed all along the line with increased majorities.

The election returns of Sherman county are all in but at this writing not canvassed and we are unable to give an official statement, but unofficial reports give Reese 396, Holcomb 717, Kinkaid 433, Neville 613, Hamer, 429, Sullivan 763; Brown, for county Judge 460, Angier 726; Pearson for Sheriff, 449, Snyder 688; Cressler, for treasurer 371, Badure 831; Stevens, for Clerk, 388, Minshull 804; or in other words the majorities in favor of the whole populist ticket are: Holcomb 321, Neville 320, Sullivan 329, Angier 269, Snyder 239, Badura 460, and Minshull 416.

The populists carried every township in the county except Washington and Loup City.

We will give the official tabulated statement of the vote next week.
