IDAHO AND KENTUCKY IN DOUBT.

McKinley has 281 Electoral Votes, Bryan 142 In Doubt 24.—Sherman County Behaves Nicely and Gives Substantial Gains for Prosperity.

The democrats have been saved from themselves again, and will they be thankful.

From all over the country comes the glad tidings that President McKinley has been re-elected by an electoral vote larger than he received in 1896. He not only carried all the states that he did in '96 but many of them by increased majorities.

The vote in the United States Tuesday clearly indicates that the democratic party did not dare trust our country to their chosen standard bearer. Who can trust a party that will nominate men that they dare not trust themselves.

The Republican candidates for congress in the First and Second districts are elected, the other four districts are in doubt with the chances in favor of fusion. Seventeen counties in the Sixth gives Kinkaid a majority of 468, which possibly will be wiped out when all counties are in.

McKinley prosperity will drive the ship of state for four years more, and the stars and stripes will continue to wave over the Philippines. The following is a list of states that have been reported:

OHIO. McKinley's native state surpasses her former record and delights the hearts of the people by giving her favorite son an increased majority over four years ago. NEBRASKA. All indications are that McKinley carries the state and the legislature will be Republican on joint ballot by about 33. NEW YORK. New York gave a clean republican majority of 150,000. MARYLAND. This state which has always been placed in the Democratic column until four years ago has given McKinley 13,000. WEST VIRGINIA. This state gives McKinley a plurality over all his opponents of 17,000. NEW JERSEY. New Jersey is still in the prosperity column by a plurality of 65,000. MICHIGAN. McKinley carries this state by a plurality of over 50,000 and the state republican ticket was elected by 40,000. IOWA. gives over 100,000 for McKinley. CONNECTICUT. west republican by a reduced majority. Figures not given. INDIANA. Latest returns on Indiana places her in the republican column by a plurality of from 25,000 to 30,000. RHODE ISLAND. McKinley has carried Rhode Island by 17,000 plurality. WISCONSIN. The latest estimates on this state gives her to McKinley by 100,000 a gain of about 4,000 over '96. MAINE. This state gives republican party a return of majority. PENNSYLVANIA. The republican state as usual rolls up a large majority for the Republican ticket. MONTANA. McKinley's majority in this state is estimated at 100,000.

MASSACHUSETTS. The Bay state true to her traditions stands by McKinley prosperity. CALIFORNIA. With the other western states sat down on imperialism with a dull thud. Its majority will reach about 40,000. SOUTH DAKOTA. She has returned to the Republican fold and Pettigrew is starting a new party to supersede the corpse. KANSAS. Bleeding Kansas dropped down on sockless Jerry and made her mark high enough above that of last year so that there can be no disputing it. NORTH CAROLINA. gives Bryan a plurality of from 25,000 to 30,000. SOUTH CAROLINA. South Carolina like Sherman county went democratic. TEXAS. Bryan's majority will be over 175,000. All but three of the townships of Sherman county show a substantial gain over the vote of 1896 for McKinley. The gains are as follows, Ashton and Elm being the two banner townships of the county with Loup City Scott and Harrison a close second: Oak Creek, gain for McKinley 9 Washington " " " 10 Kim " " " 41 Loup City " " " 30 Ashton " " " 43 Clay " " " 6 Harrison " " " 24 Scott " " " 29 Hazard " " " 26 Legos, gain for Bryan 7 Rockville, " " " 5 Webster, " " " 14 Bristol, no change, " " " 26 This gives McKinley a clear gain in the county of 188 or in other words Bryan's majority is reduced from that of 1896. H. Zucker, our republican candidate for senator, made a gallant fight. He carried Butte county by a majority of 7, although the county is a small majority for Bryan. In Douglas he ran with the other democrats on the ticket but owing to the heavy majority for the fusion ticket was unable to win out.

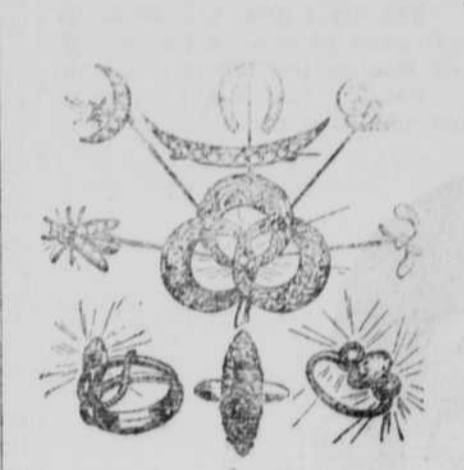
