ReElected by an Overwhelming Majority.



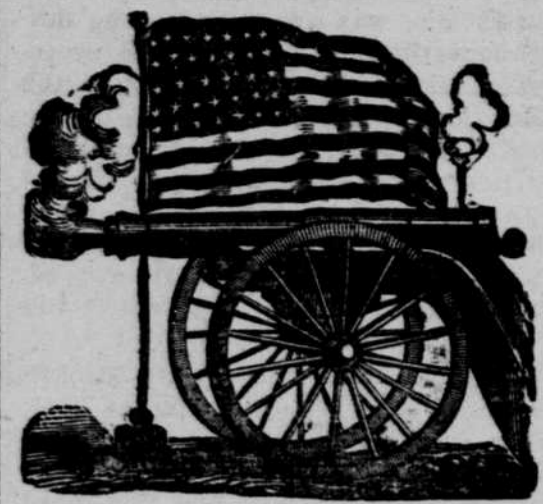
Democracy Sick

Dr. Bryan Failed to Relieve the Situation.

Everything has gone for Roosevelt, that is every northern state, Virginia, Gassaway Davis' state, gives Roosevelt 25,000, while New York turns Parker down by 228,000. This gives Roosevelt 309 electoral votes, with Parker only 144 and Colorado and Missouri in the doubtful column. The landslide to Roosevelt has been the greatest in the history of the country, and far exceeds the wildest expectations. In fact at no time was democracy in it to the slightest extent. Next week we will give full returns from every state in the union, as it is impossible at this early day to give more than a semi-official notice of the great Republican landslide and a few approximate figures.

Nebraska is claimed by the Republicans for Roosevelt by some 60,000. The fight on Mickey has been one of the most virulent in the history of the state, and that together with the ill feeling and antagonism against the new revenue law was used in every way to encompass the defeat of the head of the Republican state ticket, but most dismally failed and he and the rest of the state ticket were elected by handsome majorities, while the legislature is safely Republican.

Senator Aaron Wall Carries The County by Eighty-five Votes.

It Is Representative Horatio Smelser Now, and He Won by 9 Votes.

Uncle Joe Pedler Sprints into the County Attorney's Office with 116 Votes to the Good.



Sherman county is all right. She has given Roosevelt and the Republican state and county ticket good majorities from Teddy down to road overseers, with the exception of Mickey for governor. Notwithstanding the bitter fight made on County Attorney J. S. Pedlar, both in and outside party lines, he has been re-elected by 116 majority. Senator Wall carries the county by 85, which is far in excess of that given him two years ago. Buffalo advices from all but four townships gave Judge Wall 300 majority. A nasty fight was made on him in Buffalo county nearly the last moment and too late to give the lies a good airing, but they seem to have mired in their own wallow of filth and indecency. Mr. Smelser landed safe, if only by a slight majority of 9 and will be the first Republican representative Sherman county has had in the legislature since 1888—or sixteen long years. W. O. Brown and Henning Clausen were easy winners for supervisors in their representative districts. Below we give the official returns of Sherman county of the leading candidates, giving full official returns next week.

The county vote is as follows. National, republicans 809, democrats 140, populists 423, prohibition 21, socialists 44. For governor: Mickey 669, Berge 593. For congressman, Kinkaid 706, McNeel 649. State senator Wall 740, Hand 655. Representative, Smelser 678, Kittell 669. County attorney, Pedler 748, Mathew 632. The following supervisors are elected: Dist. No. 1, Fred Schroll populist, No. 2, Henning Clausen, republican, No. 3, W. O. Brown, republican, No. 5, R. M. Hiddleston, populist, No. 7, W. H. Chapman, populist. Next week we will publish the tabulated statement of the votes in full.
