**ASKS \$50,000 FOR AFFECTIONS**

Mrs. Laura M. Newbecker, wife of George Newbecker, an automobile dealer of Ord, filed suit in the district court Monday for damages to the amount of \$50,000, which she alleges she has suffered through Dr. Newbecker alienating the affections of her husband. This is the largest damage suit, from point of the amount asked for, that has ever been asked for in this county, and is peculiar in that Dr. Newbecker is a sister of the husband of the plaintiff.

Mrs. Newbecker charges in her petition filed with the district clerk that soon after her marriage to George Newbecker, the latter was deeply attached to her but that shortly afterward the defendant conceived and harbored an intense dislike for the plaintiff and that she maliciously and wrongfully sought to prejudice the mind of Mr. Newbecker against her and to alienate his affections from her. She charges that this was done by coaxing and intimidations and that she finally succeeded in causing her husband to leave and desert her.

She alleges further that for the purpose of turning Mr. Newbecker against his wife Dr. Newbecker falsely represented to him that the plaintiff was extravagant and squander all his property and for the purpose of placing him more completely in her power induced him to execute a note to defendant in the sum of \$4,000 with the intention of increasing her power and influence over.

According to the plaintiff, she and Mr. Newbecker were married in Grand Island on June 16, 1909 and that they lived together for some time after their marriage. Dr. Newbecker is a practicing physician in this city having been here for many years in that profession. Mr. Newbecker is a brother of Dr. Newbecker and has for some time been operating an
