Sunday School Lesson

Subject—"Jesus Crosses Racial Boundries."
Scripture—John 4: 1-42
Memory verse—"Whosoever drinketh the water that I shall give him shall never thirst."
John 4:14.
—The lesson down to date—
Jesus was always interested in people. Racial differences, sex, Economic conditions did not matter in the least degree to Him.
We find many interesting things in this lesson pertaining to the character of Jesus.
He had no false dignity. He would speak to a stranger. He had no race prejudice. A Samaritan needed the light as well as a Jew. This woman was also poor.
His approach was perfect. He

asked a favor. He knew how to make contact.
