## Sunday School Lesson

Subject-Jesus the Giver of Life. Scripture Text- John 4: 46-51 Memory Verse-"I am the resurrection and the life; he that believeth in me, through he were dead, yet shall he live." John 11: 25..

- The lesson down to date -

In today's lesson we find three situations in which Jesus gives life to those in need.
