Sunday School Lesson

Subject—Feeding the Five Thousand
Scripture Text—John 6: 25-35
Memory Verse—"I am the bread of life." John 6: 48.
- The lesson down to date -
In this lesson there is a striking difference between the thinking of Jesus and his disciples.

That the people who came to hear the words of Jesus were hungry and far from home, they were agreed.

The disciples approach their Lord and ask Him to send the people away, for there is not money enough to buy bread for them all.

Jesus asked them what was available. They answered "there is a lad here with five barley loaves and two fishes."
